Make our home a real dwelling place of peace, joy and love, where you are ever present among us. #### First Reading: Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14

Sirach emphasizes the importance of honoring one's parents. He explains that spiritual riches will come to those who are kind to their mother and father.

THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH

#### Second Reading: Colossians 3:12-21

Paul advises us to treat each other with kindness and mercy and to forgive as God forgives us. His words remind families to always love and respect one another and let Christ's peace reign in their hearts and in their homes.

#### Gospel: Luke 2:41-52

When Jesus was twelve years old, the Holy Family traveled to Jerusalem to celebrate the feast. Jesus did not return with the company. Instead, he stayed in Jerusalem, sitting among the teachers while amazing them with his understanding and questions. When found by his concerned parents, Jesus reminded them that he must be in the house of his Father. Returning together, Mary kept these things in her heart.

#### A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph December 26, 2021

"Thinking he was in the caravan, they journeyed for a day, and looked for him among their relatives and acquaintances, but not finding him, they returned to Jerusalem to look for him... When his parents saw him, they were astonished, and his mother said to him, 'Son why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety."

The care and concern of Joseph and Mary is no different than that of our parents today. We worry, provide for, and breathe filled with anxiety for the well being of our family.

Imagine time spent in the shop of the carpenter, the hours spent in the kitchen, time for prayer and pilgrimage. What happened in Nazareth, happens in our lives today.

Reading the Word of God, may we be like His parents, and spend time 'looking for Jesus' and when we discover Him, enjoy His presence in our homes.


